**Balance Sheet** ~ No significant changes from the prior reporting period.

# **Profit and Loss Budget Vs. Actuals:**

#### • Zone 1 ~

- o Revenues are in line with budget
- Expenditures are under budget for the year to date. Actual expenditures are \$30k, budgeted is \$142k, providing a variance of \$112k under budget. All expenditure line items are underbudget, but technical costs and seawall inspection comprise \$77k of the underbudget number.
- o YTD revenue over expenditures provide for a \$201k YTD profit.
- Note-since this report was written an invoice for \$1347.50 was received from Cal Engineering.

#### • Zone 2 ~

- o Revenues are in line with budget
- o Expenditures as well, with only small budget to actual variances.
- O YTE revenue over expenditures provide for a YTD loss of \$10k. This loss includes depreciation, which represents \$58k of the YTD expenses, and is a not cash item.






